- 3. <u>Dale Vogel, Hoffman House Catering:</u> Dale Vogel stated he is working on the fall/winter menu. The Grinnell Hall picnic will be held on July 30, 2009 at Telfer Park. The Hoffman House catering manager is off on maternity leave; two other staff members are replacing her until her return to work.
