BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the General Service Committee be delegated the authority to approve all change orders for the Rock Haven Replacement Project and report any change orders over \$10,000 to the Rock County Board of Supervisors at its regularly scheduled meeting."

Supervisor Collins moved approval of the resolution, second by Supervisor Brill. ADOPTED.

<u>Update Report</u> Mr. Higgs reported the following:

Work is proceeding on the stairs; work continues on the punch-list and corrections are being worked on; the porch work may be going out for bid. Ms. Gunderson said there have been some oversights such as no water lines for washing the carts; a dishwasher with no plumbing; door ratings on the stair wells; signs on the doors to the courtyard; and staff did request two additional lights in the food prep area. Mr. Higgs said he will be going through the list for items to be investigated.

Change Orders Mr. Higgs reported the following:

Program Request #25 (COR#172) pertaining to fire dampers for a cost of \$9,812.00; (COR#173) pertaining to the chiller bypass for a cost of \$7,431.00; (COR#182) pertaining to the FA alarm system and the nurse call system for a cost of \$4,598.00; (COR#188) pertaining to the domestic water piping for a cost of \$20,055.00; (COR#189) pertaining to card reader access control for a cost of \$1,338.00; (COR#190) pertaining to the City of Janesville Electrical Inspector requests for a cost of \$3,034.00; (COR#192) pertaining to exhaust fans in oxygen storage for a cost of \$1,217.00; (COR#193) pertaining to the City of Janesville Building Inspector requests for a cost of \$4,377.00. (Due to timing constraints, several of the items were subject to review by the architect/engineer and/or further negotiations.) For a total cost of \$51,862.00.

Program Request #26 consists of two extended general conditions or delay claims:

- (COR#178) pertaining to C.G. Schmidt for a cost of \$358,400.00. A negotiated settlement of \$110,615.00 is appropriate.
- (COR#183) pertaining to the subcontractor claim requesting a four month time extension for a cost of \$366,543.00. This has been denied.

Supervisor Collins moved approval of Program Request #25 and #26 in the amount of \$161,862.00, second by Supervisor Brill. ADOPTED.

Communications, Announcements and Information.

Set Meeting Date for UW-Rock Mass Notification Report Mr. Leu reported that April 23, 2013 was the date that worked for everyone and asked if the Committee wanted to have this as a special meeting or if they wanted to incorporate this report into one of the other April General Services meetings.
