1. Call to Order

6. Secretary's Report

Mr. Somppi reported on the City of Janesville's recent monitoring of the HOME Consortium Program. Staff are working to address issues that must be corrected to meet program compliance. The current focus involves modifications to the Community Development Policies and Procedures Manual. Discussion followed concerning the various items that are needed to be added or amended in the current manual.

Colin Byrnes discussed the recent monitoring of both CDBG and HOME Programs and the Findings and Concerns that were brought out from that monitoring. The County's response to the HOME monitoring is due by May 23rd.

Chair Christiansen asked about the eligibility status of previously approved HOME projects. In response, Randy Terronez stated that Staff are currently working to make that determination.

Discussion followed regarding the possibility of having an outside contractor perform the administration of the Community Development Program.

Commission members will act on HOME monitoring corrective actions at the next Housing Authority meeting scheduled for May 5th.
