<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Podzilni called the meeting of the County Board Staff Committee to order at 4:00 P.M. in Conference Room N1 on the fifth floor of the Rock County Courthouse-East.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>. Supervisor Arnold moved approval of the agenda with the addition of a Pre-Approved Encumbrance for Human Resources, second by Supervisor Peer. ADOPTED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements</u>. The members of the Ho-Chunk Nation introduced themselves.

Supervisor Sweeney said he spent the morning with WisDOT, WSOR and WRRTC discussing the *Wisconsin Rail Issues and Opportunities Report* and the Rail is in good shape. He added that the rail car count is up from the past few years.

Supervisor Bussie said the restaurant will be going back on the April agenda with a follow-up and the pros and cons of finishing the space off.

Supervisor Brill moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Peer.

Mr. Kuglitsch said the agreement is nearing expiration and this is for an additional three years.

Mr. Springer said three years ago they thought this would be enough time but the application is moving along and the Nation is still interested.

Mr. Kuglitsch said the Nation has already approved this IGA and the City of Beloit approved it the previous night.

Supervisor Kraft said the resolution does not have a date specific on it.

Supervisor Kraft moved to have "from today's date" added to the end of line 34, second by Supervisor Bussie. ADOPTED.

Discussion on a town hall type meeting being held in the near future to keep the public informed of the progress; and the minimum wage being raised to \$10 per hour by the Nation.

Opposing Countywide Property Assessment Proposals as Presented in State Budget

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk be authorized and directed to send a copy of this resolution to Governor Walker and the Rock County Legislative Delegation."

Supervisor Thomas moved to approve the above resolution, second by Supervisor Kraft.

Chair Podzilni stated the WCA is also opposed to this item.

Supervisor Kraft said she feels it was included in the budget, but she doesn't think it was totally thought through before being put in the budget.

Mr. Osborne said this would be, partially, an unfunded mandate. He added that the County would need to have an Assessment Officer and staff, who the state would determine how many, how much to pay them, and who is qualified.

Supervisor Sweeney said he will support this opposition because it is so unclear, but he feels the creation of a level playing field is the best way to go.

Supervisor Kraft said if it were thought out beforehand it may be good but as it is written now it is very unclear.

Mr. Kuglitsch said the County would also need to create a Board of Review.

Amending the 2015 Budget to Create 1.0 FTE Maintenance Worker IV for Job Center

Mr. Osborne said the money is in the budget for this position and we have a stop gap measure in place until the end of April or early May.

<u>Discussion and Possible Action – Request from Rock County Historical Society to Use Rock County Logo.</u> Moved by Supervisor Sweeney to approve the use of the Rock County Logo by the Rock County Historical Society, second by Supervisor Peer.

Supervisor Sweeney said he would recommend the County not allow the use of the logo as this is how it has been handled in the past.

FAILED with the following vote: Ayes – none; No – Supervisors Podzilni, Kraft, Arnold, Brill, Bussie, Peer, Sweeney and Thomas; Absent – Supervisor Mawhinney.

ADOPTED on a roll call vote with the following: Ayes – Supervisors Arnold, Brill, Bussie, Sweeney, Kraft, Peer, Podzilni and Thomas. Supervisor Mawhinney was absent.

Chair Podzilni announced that the Committee would meet in closed session per Section 19.85(1)(g) Wis. Stats. Confer with Legal Counsel Regarding Possible Litigation.

Supervisor Arnold moved to go out of Executive Session at 5:05 P.M., second by Supervisor Thomas. ADOPTED.
