### **Staff Report:**

<u>Internships:</u> Tanya Kelly shared some of her experiences interning during her second semester. Commendations were given by COA staff for her excellent work.

<u>Youth Services:</u> Provided decorated bags and shamrock pins for those receiving home delivered meals.

<u>WAND Conference:</u> Ranee Goodroad will attend their annual conference in Stevens Point on April 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>.

<u>Nutrition Education Handout – Home Delivered Meals:</u> The most recent nutrition education handout, "Instructions for Reheating Food Safely in the Microwave", was distributed. The handout will also be available at dining centers.

<u>Revised Actual Cost of Meal:</u> Due to closure of congregate dining sites, the actual cost per meal has lowered to \$8.97 per meal.

#### Old Business:

<u>Program Evaluations Update:</u> Ranee Goodroad shared preliminary findings from the annual program evaluations of the home delivered meals and dining centers. It was noted that many respondents indicated they receive ½ of their daily food intake from the meal provided through the COA. A complete report will be given at the April meeting.

#### **New Business:**

<u>Evaluation Cards for Congregate Program:</u> To provide on-going program evaluation, a brief survey card is being developed and will be made available at the dining centers. This will provide an opportunity for diners to give feedback at anytime.
