Executive Summary

Executive Summary

The Rock County Public Health Department's Preparedness Program focuses on preparing for, and responding to health events, threats, emergencies or disasters that pose a risk to the health of its residents. Six employees applied for and were awarded scholarships for conference attendance. Each scholarship applicant was tasked with describing the proposed benefit of conference attendance and each scholarship awardee will provide a written summary describing what was learned and how it was beneficial. This is a professional development opportunity to improve public health preparedness efforts in Rock County.
