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Permit Provisions and Conditions of Issuance

- 1. Pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes, this permit is granted to allow performance of the specific work described herein. The following standard provisions and any included special provisions shall govern.
- 2. The permitted facilities shall, if necessary, be altered at the expense of the applicant to permit alteration, improvement, or maintenance of the highway as may hereafter be ordered. The entire cost of constructing and maintaining the permitted facilities shall be the obligation of the applicant.
- 3. Any permitted facilities that are installed and found not to be in compliance with all terms and conditions of the permit shall be removed at the expense of the applicant.
- 4. No open cutting for a crossing will be allowed where the pavement is too narrow to maintain one-way traffic at all times, unless the Permitting Authority has granted permission for a detour. Wherever the pavement is opened, the soil shall be hauled away and the trench shall be backfilled with sand or gravel and compacted. The pavement removed for a road crossing shall be replaced using nine (9) inches of crushed lime rock and four (4) inches of hot-mixed asphalt compacted per the Permitting Authority specifications, unless an exception is granted.
- 5. When one-way traffic or a detour is used, the contractor shall provide all necessary signs, flag persons and lights required according to the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices." When a detour is allowed, local newspapers, radio stations, law enforcement and fire authorities, postmaster and school bus operators shall be notified by the contractor in advance of the work being started.
- 6. All disturbed areas shall be returned to their present condition or better, subject to the satisfaction of the Permitting Authority or his representative. Access to all private drives and public road intersections shall be maintained, and all disturbed areas completely restored.
- 7. Any trenching, tunneling, or excavating shall be performed in accordance with the requirements of OSHA and the Wisconsin Department of Commerce, and any applicable local regulations.
- 8. A copy of this approval along with any plans and special provisions shall be available on the job site.
