ROCK COUNTY HUMAN SERVICES BOARD MEETING Monday, November 25, 2019 – 8:00 A.M.

<u>Call to Order</u>: Chair Knudson called the meeting to order at 8:02 a.m. on Monday, November 25, 2019, in the 3rd Floor Conference room at the Health Care Center, Janesville, Wisconsin.

<u>Committee Members Present</u>: Brian Knudson, Supervisor; Terry Thomas, Supervisor; Terry Fell, Supervisor; Kathy Schulz, Supervisor; Stephanie Aegerter, Supervisor; Shirley Williams, Citizen Representative; and David Homan, Supervisor.

<u>Committee Members Absent</u>: Sally Jean Weaver-Landers, Citizen Representative. Ashley Kleven, Citizen Representative.

<u>Staff Present</u>: Kate Luster, Director; Tera O'Connor, Deputy Director; Megan Learn, Administrative Intern; Kimber Blum, CPS Training Supervisor; Stefanie Getchell, CPS Training Lead Worker.

Others Present: Jamie Fugate, Community. Sue Rusch, Community.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>: Supervisor Aegerter moved the agenda to the floor, seconded by Citizen Representative Williams. The agenda was unanimously approved. APPROVED.

Approval of Minutes of Human Services Board Meeting of November 13, 2019: Supervisor Aegerter moved the minutes to the floor, seconded by Supervisor Thomas. The minutes were unanimously approved. APPROVED.

<u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements</u>: Citizen Representative Williams recognized this week for celebrating being thankful and wished everyone a happy Thanksgiving.

<u>Submission of Committee Requests</u>: Supervisor Schulz asked that the agenda item she requested previously about the housing crisis to be placed on the agenda soon.

Supervisor Aegerter asked for an item on the Foster Care system and building trust foster parents. Ms. Luster advised she would give a brief update under the Director's Report and will put Foster Care update on the next HSD Board meeting agenda.

Citizen Representative Williams asked for information on suicide conditions in Rock County.

Supervisor Schulz asked for an update in January on the Birth to 3 transition.

<u>Approval of Contracts and Transfers</u>: Supervisor Fell moved nine contracts to the floor, seconded by Supervisor Thomas. Ms. Luster explained many of the contracts were amendments for updated rates with providers HSD continues to utilize. She highlighted the Tellurian contact and provided more details. She responded to questions about other counties using the Youth Services Center (YSC). The contracts were unanimously approved. APPROVED.

November Human Services Department (HSD) Employee Impact Award Recognition: Ms. Luster introduced Stefanie Getchell the recipient of the November HSD Employee Impact award. Ms. Getchell is the lead worker in the CPS training unit. Ms. Getchell received a couple nominations which included how she shows positivity in all her interactions, does not tolerate gossip, comes to work every day with a smile on her face, she worries about her team and ensures her time off does not impact her workmates. She models HSDs Commitment to Coworkers. Ms. Luster added that Ms. Getchell is an example of the organizational culture piece that HSD is working hard on trying to shift, change and support. Ms. Luster introduced Kimber Blum, Ms. Getchell's supervisor who was in attendance. Ms. Getchell expressed thanks.

2019 HSD Quarterly Budget Report: Ms. Luster explained this is a summary of the general ledger data from the end of September which shows under budget at that time. She explained there are many factors that are still unknown such as reconciliations that come at the end of the year and revenue that comes at different times throughout the year.

She highlighted the Behavioral Health (BH) Division Comprehensive Community Services (CCS) year to date and provided details about the projected revenue and low expenditures. She responded to questions about the revenue reimbursements, reconciliation cycles, and out of home placement trending.

Director's Report:

- Update on 1717 Center Avenue (New HSD location) Ms. Luster explained that the architect is now getting into specific design of cubicles, bathrooms and space. The Job Center partners are requesting additional space beyond what they originally requested, which may be difficult to accommodate. Ms. Luster responded to questions.
- Update on Birth to 3 Transition Ms. O'Connor advised that last week there were two meetings held one meeting with HSD and United Cerebral Palsy (UCP), and another meeting with HSD, UCP and CESA 2. It has been challenging working out some of the details of the transition. The meetings included working out managing the electronic health record and the phone message when CESA 2 is no longer in business. HSD and UCP are having some joint meetings with families. UCP has most staff hired, but will be contracting Speech Therapists for the time being until permanent staff are hired. Ms. O'Connor has been problem solving with individual families and one HSD staff member is helping families in dual programs. HSD is doing outreach with families to make sure they are receiving information that has been sent and that they know who to contact. On December 2, 2019 UCP will pick up all calls. Ms. Luster advised the Director from UCP will be introduced at the next HSD Board meeting and answer questions. Citizen Representative Williams provided clarification that CESA 2 is not Birth to 3. Some people are confused about this. Birth to 3 is the program and CESA 2 was subcontracted to provide the services. Ms. Luster responded to questions about monitoring UCP,

transitional funds, and about reporting back to the Board about the families' experiences and the program budget.

Emergency Housing Funded by RCHSD Jan 1, 2018 – Oct 31, 2019

Adult Protective Services

Adult Protective Services (APS) is responsible for investigating allegations of abuse and neglect of any adult over the age of 18 who has a disability or any adult who is 60 or older. In addition to investigations, staff assist with petitioning the court for Guardianship and Protective Placement for individuals who have been deemed incompetent.

The APS unit occasionally provides emergency housing and food for individuals who meet the vulnerable adult definition and whose needs cannot be met in other ways (such as through a shelter).

Situations in which APS would utilize funds to assist someone in this manner are:

- Current living arrangement is noted as uninhabitable by housing authority or close to.
- Individual has intensive medical needs and is unable to care for self.
- Individual has intensive medical needs and caregiver is unable to assist adequately or safely.
- Individual is being abused in some form and abuser lives in home.

When housing assistance is provided and depending on the needs of the individual, APS will call upon:

- Community Based Residential Facilities (CBRFs) such as Our House, Sun Valley, Cartographics, Azura, or Productive Living Systems.
- Adult Family Homes (AFHs)
- Motels such as Motel 6, Northern Town, Lannon Stone, or Driftwood.

When individuals do not require the care/oversight at a CBRF or AFH and a motel is sought out, there have been instances where APS has provided food from the HSD food pantry or utilized petty cash to cover the cost of groceries until the individual or APS has secured another more permanent/safe housing option.

Behavioral Health Division

Rock County Crisis Services provides services 24 hours a day, seven days a week to people of all ages who are experiencing a mental health or alcohol/drug related emergency. Services are delivered in-person, in the community or by phone.

The Crisis program provides individuals with emergency housing by issuing vouchers funded through the Crisis budget. Assistance may be in the form of motel vouchers or vouchers for security deposits or first month's rent for personal apartments and/or shared living spaces such as sober living. Motels that are typically used include the Del Mae Motel, Driftwood Motel, Lannon Stone Motel, Motel 6, and the Northern Town Motel.

Housing vouchers are used when individuals have an identified Mental Health concern and the assistance will help prevent a cost burden elsewhere in the HSD budget, for example to divert or prevent hospitalization or an Emergency Detention, to divert or prevent incarceration or in an emergency situation in which an individual or family would be at physical or emotional risk that would be considered a crisis and impact mental health or cause trauma. Vouchers are typically used in situations where there is a specific plan for the post-vouchering period. The length of the vouchering is determined on a case by case basis in accordance with the guidelines outlined above. Sometimes vouchers are used before a long-term plan has been developed to allow time for the individual to reach out to natural supports and work with other community agencies to work towards a more sustainable plan.

Individuals who receive services from other Behavioral Health programs such Comprehensive Community Services, the Community Support Program, or the Children's Long Term Support program may occasionally receive housing assistance as well. Circumstances that were cited recently by these programs included an emergency situation after a fire and other cases where a family unexpectedly lost their housing and needed time to find a new home.

When individuals are in need of food and there is no way to access a community agency, staff provide food from the Crisis pantry or the HSD food pantry. There is a need for "ready to eat" food items as individuals may not have access to a kitchen. Staff may also use flex funds to buy groceries.

Children, Youth and Families (CYF) Division

The Children, Youth and Families Division (CYF) is composed of Child Protective Services (CPS), Youth Justice (YJ) and the Youth Services Center (YSC). The Division's work is guided by the need to protect children from maltreatment and ensure public safety and youth accountability by using evidenced-based programs and practices to increase the skills and competencies of clients to promote positive behavior change.

CYF occasionally provides financial assistance for families that are currently involved in the CPS or YJ system and whose needs cannot be met in other ways.

Situations in which CYF would utilize funds to assist families in this manner are:

- Parents are currently homeless or were just evicted and there are children living with them. The
 department attempts to link them to community resources that can provide temporary housing such as
 shelters. If that resource is unavailable, the department provides temporary hotel vouchers.
- Parents whose children are living in their home that are financially struggling and at risk of eviction. The department on occasion have assisted with rent for a month to prevent the eviction from occurring.
- Parents whose children are residing in their home that are financially struggling and cannot afford
 groceries. The department has attempted to link the family to economic support, food pantries or
 churches for assistance. If that does not resolve the issue, the department has supplied the family with
 groceries.
