#### TO RECOGNIZE LINDA SIME

WHEREAS, Linda Sime has served the citizens of Rock County for over twenty-nine (29) years as a dedicated and valued employee of Rock County; and,

WHEREAS, Linda Sime began her Rock County career on February 9, 1987 as a Community Education Specialist. After nearly six years in that position, Ms. Sime transferred to a Case Manager located at the Merrill Community Center. Her personnel file is packed with notes expressing gratitude to Ms. Sime for her community work with schools and other agencies during this time. Also, during these first years with Rock County, Ms. Sime served on the Board of Directors of the Wisconsin Prevention Network and with Protective Behaviors Inc. where she was a board member and a trainer. In 1991, Ms. Sime was invited to Australia to teach this child abuse prevention curriculum; and,

WHEREAS, after a brief role as a Case Manager in the Community Support Program, Ms. Sime became licensed as a Clinical Social Worker and in 1995, Ms. Sime settled into a Master Social Worker position at the Janesville Counseling Center. She remains in this position, where she has thrived for over 20 years, and continues until the day of her retirement. In this role, Ms. Sime has been the primary psychotherapist for thousands of Rock County residents. She has engaged with consumers who are struggling with a myriad of difficult behavioral health problems including depression, anxiety, suicide, substance abuse, and trauma. She has helped consumers overcome these challenges as well as assisting them to meet their basic needs such as housing, food, and access to healthcare. Ms. Sime has worked closely with many colleagues through the years, both Rock County staff and community partners; and,

WHEREAS, Linda Sime allows her heart to guide her as a Social Worker. She cares deeply about the consumers with whom she works and has been a tireless advocate to help people improve their lives. Ms. Sime has helped a multitude of people through very difficult times in their lives, including the inevitable end of life challenges that people face. She has been present and available to many people who have simply needed someone to listen. Ms. Sime has also been a meticulous record keeper. She takes pride in her timely and detailed documentation both related to consumer records as well as administrative paperwork.
