Amending the 2014 Human Services Department Budget To Accept Funding for the Treatment Alternative Program

Executive Summary

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) awarded \$315,119 in Treatment Alternative Program funding through the State and County Contract Covering Social Services and Community Programs. Funding has previously been given to Rock County but was not included in the 2014 HSD Budget as DHS was expected to award the funding on a competitive basis through a request for proposal (RFP) process. Our understanding is that they will now be issuing a RFP for 2015 funding.

Treatment Alternative Program funds in Rock County are used to provide treatment as an alternative to incarceration for alcohol and other drug abusers (AODA) involved in the criminal justice system through a contract with Rock Valley Community Programs.

No additional county funds are required.

RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE JOYCE HEREFORD

WHEREAS, Joyce Hereford has served the citizens of Rock County for over thirty-five (35) years as a dedicated and valued employee of Rock County; and

WHEREAS, Joyce Hereford began her career on September 18, 1978, as a social worker in the Child Protective Services Division. During her time there, she assisted in both the intake and assessment unit as well as the ongoing unit. Ms. Hereford supported families with the goal of uniting them back together as a family unit. Ms. Hereford had great success in this role as many of the families she worked with were able to reunite and function together after her work was concluded. On February 24, 1986 Ms. Hereford transferred to the Single Parent unit where her focus was with unwed mothers; teaching them good parenting skills and helping them find childcare while they tried to continue getting an education. In 1991, when the Single Parent unit closed, Ms. Hereford was transferred to the Child Protective Services Division where she case managed families and also assisted in child abuse and neglect investigations. While in that unit she maintained an ongoing caseload and again worked to help keep families intact. On April 6, 1992, Ms. Hereford began her career in Long Term Support. Ms. Hereford enjoyed helping frail elderly and physically disabled adults; improving the quality of their life by coordinating services that assisted to keep people out of nursing homes, and remain as independent as possible in their own homes or a community setting; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Hereford went into Social Work to *help* others. She advocated and worked on behalf of her clients; searching for services to meet their needs and providing quality case management. Ms. Hereford has demonstrated through her actions her belief in the "Golden Rule" by treating others the way in which she would like to be treated. Her compassion to help individuals with disabilities has benefited hundreds of people in the community. Ms. Hereford will be retiring from Rock County Department of Human Services on March 14, 2014, and

WHEREAS, Joyce Hereford has proven herself to be a compassionate and caring employee, advocating on behalf of Rock County residents; and

WHEREAS, the Rock County Board of Supervisors, representing the citizens of Rock County, wishes to recognize Joyce Hereford for her achievements and significant contributions to the citizens of Rock County and her lifelong and faithful service.

WHEREAS, the Social Workers of the Rock County Department of Human Services provide services to a wide variety of Rock County citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Rock County Board of Supervisors, representing the citizens of Rock County, wish to

WHEREAS, the Social Workers in the Mental Health and AODA Division area provide a wide array of welcoming and strengths based treatment and rehabilitation interventions to adults, youth and families living with mental illness and other complex problems thereby reducing the need for restrictive institutional care and out of home placement; and facilitate access to treatment and recovery supports for individuals with substance abuse and co-occurring disorders to assist individuals with overcoming challenges and improving quality of life; and
