




Change Orders to the Contract for Upgrading Exterior Lighting at the Public Works Facility in Janesville

This is two change orders being request for the project of upgrading current exterior light fixtures and adding additional pole lights at the Public Works garage in Janesville. The current lights were metal halide, higher energy consuming fixtures and were be replaced with new LED low energy consuming fixtures or bulbs. There were 11 fixtures we spec'd to have retrofitted with LED light bulbs. The output bulb that was specified by the engineer would not fit in the fixture. Therefore we are needing to replace the entire fixture for proper lighting output. The one change order cost is \$5.738 with Van Brocklin Electric LLC of Janesville WI. We had no contingency funds included in the original resolution in an amount of \$38,600.00. However there is still \$18,900 in the budget for this project. The second change order is a credit of \$500 for some asphalt patching Rock County DPW crew completed the work.
