## **Budget Review.**

**County Board** Mr. Knutson said the 2014 tax levy is the same as 2013.

<u>County Administrator</u> Mr. Knutson said this is a cost to continue budget. The tax levy is up 1.8% from the prior year.

<u>Corporation Counsel</u> Mr. Kuglitsch said his budget is a cost to continue. Mr. Kuglitsch said the tax levy shows a decrease of 5.3% due to the codification project being finished up using County staff.

<u>Human Resources</u> Mr. O'Connell said there is a little change in the staffing pattern and they are requesting a SMART Board to use for new employee orientations and County Board committee meetings. Mr. Knutson said the tax levy is down \$45,389 or 8.2% from the prior year.
