WHEREAS, Rock Haven has mandated the COVID-19 vaccine for all staff;

WHEREAS, COVID-19 cases number 165 in the Rock County jail inmate population;

WHEREAS, COVID-19 cases number 13 in the Rock Haven resident population;

WHEREAS, similar to Rock Haven, the jail population includes individuals vulnerable to COVID-19, including those with health conditions of obesity, heart disease, and other serious health issues;

WHEREAS, Rock County correctional officers have not been mandated to be administered a COVID 11 19 vaccine;

WHEREAS, the Rock County personnel ordinance states "It is the policy of the County to treat all employees equitably and fairly in matters affecting their employment".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this ______ day of ______, 20___ orders the discontinuation of the Rock Haven mandated COVID-19 vaccination policy. Rock Haven may not require staff to receive a COVID-19 vaccine, and will recall those employees on layoff status due to the mandated vaccine policy in accordance with the Rock County Personnel Ordinance and Policy and Procedure Manual.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Board highly recommends the vaccine for all employees.

The decision on whether to require vaccines of staff is first a clinical assessment of what is in the best interest of residents, but is also weighed against competing interests of staff concerns, liability, and general public policy.
