<u>ISSUE</u> - Controlled access highway driveway permit approval

DISCUSSION - CTH M is a controlled access highway as defined under Rock County Ordinance Chapter 4, Part 5 — County Trunk Highway Access Control Regulations. The applicant, Mr. John Borgwardt, wants to add a private entrance to a parcel with an existing private entrance. (See attached map)

In discussion with the property owner, he is considering subdividing the parcel and is looking to obtain access for the proposed subdivided parcel.

The primary purpose for a controlled access ordinance is to protect the asset of the county highway and to promote the safe, efficient flow of traffic. Every driveway entrance or side road interferes with traffic flow. Either crashes or travel delays occur as more conflicts are permitted.

The ordinance sets standards stating no access permits shall be issued where horizontal distance between access points is less than 600 feet and a maximum of eight access points per side per mile of highway shall be permitted.

The ordinance also states that after designation of a controlled-access highway, no owners or occupants of parcels of land created after enactment of the ordinance will have the right or easement of access, by reason of the fact that their property abuts the controlled-access highway.

The proposed access location will not meet the access spacing requirements.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u> – Denial.

- Executive Summary -

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize the purchase 110 mobile and 8 portable two-way radios for the Department of Public Works (DPW), Highway Division. \$132,000 was included in the Department's 2017 budget for this purpose.

The DPW radios are based on analogue technology. Radio manufacturers are no longer producing these radios, in response to demand for better quality provided by digital radios. The current DPW radios are over ten years old and are failing or not getting good radio coverage due to this less reliable analogue platform.

This resolution is one of two that will be proposed in 2017 and follows up a resolution approved in 2016. In 2016, DPW purchased 40 mobile radios and 10 portable radios. With the purchase of the proposed 2017 radios (110 mobile, 8 portable) all radios will have been purchased. There will be a follow-up resolution for a contract to provide the replacement of existing radios with the new radios.

This resolution is for the purchase of only those radios that can be purchased from the State Bid. There is a mail-in, manufacturer's rebate on this equipment that reduces the total cost of this phase by \$5,390.00. A copy of the General Communications' quote is attached.

Later in 2017, DPW in conjunction with the Purchasing Division will be seeking bids for installation of these radios plus purchase of related radio repeater equipment and incidental radio items.

- Executive Summary -

The Department of Public Works (DPW) Shop Foreman has formally notified the department head of his intended retirement on July 14, 2017. His last day working at the DPW Shop is scheduled for June 2, 2017. He intends to use his vacation balance between June 2, 2017 and July 14, 2017.

This position requires the ability to coordinate and regularly adapt to the fleet needs of the Department, maintain detailed records, supervise mechanic staff and understand and adapt to various types of equipment needs.

Because of these unique job requirements, it is advantageous to bring in the successor employee before the incumbent leaves for the detailed training required to fulfill the duties of the position. The department head has met with the administrator and human resources staff to plan a strategy and map a plan of recruitment for the position.

It was determined that an overlap of the two positions of at least ten weeks for an external candidate or eight weeks for an internal candidate may be needed to successfully accomplish the transition. Due to the retiring Shop Foreman utilizing his remaining vacation, the ten week position overlap for an external candidate would allow four weeks of working overlap. Eight weeks of overlap for an internal candidate would allow two weeks of working overlap.

This resolution authorizes up to ten weeks of double fill of the position for orientation and training. In review of current status of the shop portion of the DPW budget, there are available funds for the overlap. No additional funds are being requested at this time.

ISSUE: Purchase of one Trimble Universal Total Station.
