## Accepting Brownfields to Promote Health Project and Amending the 2012 Rock County Health Department Budget

### **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The City of Janesville has a comprehensive Brownfields Program that is currently underway for the prioritization, planning, and assessment of contaminated sites in the community. One of the ultimate goals of the program is to remediate sites so they can be reused for economic and environmental gain. The existence of multiple Brownfield sites in an area can contribute to measurable environmental and social injustices that can lead to poor health outcomes in a community.

The City of Janesville has requested assistance from the Rock County Health Department to ensure the public's health is included during the planning, assessment and redevelopment of Brownfield impacted areas in Janesville. In order to assist with this request, the health department applied for and was awarded a grant from the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR).

With this grant, the Rock County Health Department will engage the broader stakeholder community (residents, city officials, developers, community-based organizations) in the Brownfield redevelopment process. Stakeholders are brought together to identify health issues of importance to the community and then to identify redevelopment strategies they feel would address these health issues.

A Rock County Health Department Registered Sanitarian II and a Health Educator will work collaboratively to review environmental data from the Brownfield sites, suggest additional sampling that might be needed, organize and present at public meetings to inform the public of the assessment findings, and work with the Brownfield Program's Health Monitoring Committee and Brownfield Advisory Committee. This work will play an important role of educating the public as well as redevelopment partners, and serve to remove the misconceptions about contamination and health risk.

A 0.6 FTE limited term Health Educator position, which will be fully funded by the grant, will be created with the adoption of this resolution.

### Building A Healthier Rock County Together

Did you hear the news? Rock County was awarded a \$450,000 grant from Transform Wisconsin to help residents lead a healthier, more active lifestyle. We were one of only six counties in the state of Wisconsin chosen to receive this funding. With higher than state averages in poverty, obesity, smoking, fruit and vegetable unavailability, fast food restaurants, and physical inactivity, we have a great opportunity to build a strong community response to improve the health of all Rock County residents.

The coalition that applied for this grant was *Transform Rock County*. This group began meeting early in 2011 to collect data for the 2011 Community Health Needs Assessment. The completed report, released earlier this year, can be found online at <a href="https://www.co.rock.wi.us/health">www.co.rock.wi.us/health</a>.

Transform Rock County envisions a healthier Rock County where

- Kids eat more fresh, local fruits and vegetables at school,
- Families can exercise together at school athletic facilities, and
- Every resident has an opportunity to live in smoke-free housing.

This grant will help *Transform Rock County* make steps toward achieving these goals. The coalition consists of community partners supportive of improving the living, playing and working conditions of all Rock County residents. It is the first healthy living coalition in Rock County to include members from all four hospital systems, local health clinics, school districts, athletic facilities, youth organizations, substance abuse prevention coalitions, and government organizations.

Transform Rock County partners include Beloit Health System, Beloit Area Community Health Center, the School District of Beloit, the Boys and Girls Club of Janesville, Clinton School District, Edgerton Hospital and Health Services, HealthNet of Rock County, Mercy Health System, Partners in Prevention of Rock County, Rock County Health Department, St. Mary's Janesville Hospital, Rock County UW-Extension Office, Stateline Family YMCA, and Youth2 Youth. This diverse group of community partners is passionate about preventing obesity and tobacco use, and providing Rock County residents with neighborhoods which make it easier and safer to stay healthy.
