- EXECUTIVE SUMMARY -

AUTHORIZING APPLICATION WITH WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR COUNTY FISH AND GAME PROJECT GRANT FUNDS

Each Wisconsin County is allocated a certain amount of money annually to fund small projects on a 50/50 match basis. Rock County may apply for a maximum of \$3,000 in 2015. Parks plans to access this funding source to help pay for invasive species control at Magnolia Bluff Park. Though this funding source requires a 50% match by the County, all time and materials supplied by the Parks and Highway Divisions, as well as other community resources may be used as in-kind match. The Multi-Use Trail group and other volunteers have assisted with various invasive species control projects in the past and have expressed a strong interest in continuing the effort.

The species to be controlled using this grant is primarily buckthorn. For the past few years, we have used these funds for buckthorn and garlic mustard control in Carver-Roehl Park, and we've achieved a noticeable reduction of the invasive species. We feel the time is now appropriate to move these efforts to another area in need, such as Magnolia Bluff, especially as it is a State Natural Area.

ISSUE: Discussion and Possible Action on Rental Rates for Gibbs Lake Park Shelter

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> The Gibbs Lake Park shelter construction is nearing completion. In anticipation of the current and next rental season, rental rates for the facility need to be established. With the established park shelter rental and other permit processes, the thought is that the general department park permit form can be used for the rental of the Gibbs Lake Park Shelter. The process and fees would be the same as the other shelter facilities.
