The Resolution before you is awarding the contract for space renovation at the Job Center for the Comprehensive Community Services Program.

Comprehensive Community Services (CCS) is a $100 \%$ Medicaid funded outpatient psychosocial rehabilitation program to improve the quality of life for adults and children with mental illness, substance abuse or a co-occurring diagnosis.
