

Trail easement area in red





## AUTHORIZING APPLICATION WITH WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES FOR SNOWMOBILE GRANT FUNDS

This resolution provides authorization to apply for funding for the 2013-2014 Rock County Snowmobile Trail Program.

The DNR Snowmobile Grant of \$56,600 would cover 226.4 miles of trail. The snowmobile trail project is 100% grant funded. Any field work (includes labor, materials, and machinery) by DPW Parks Division or Highway Division is 100% billed back to the grant. The area Snowmobile Alliance provides trail signage and grooming and is reimbursed for those services after the county costs are covered.

These funds are 100% provided by the payments snowmobilers have made through license and prorated fuel tax payments. Rock County receives a 50% advance payment check after the completed contract is signed, the balance due upon final close out of the grant.

## Executive Summary Authorizing Lease and Partnership Agreement, with the Friends of Beckman Mill, Incorporated

Rock County has acquired several parcels over the years now known as Beckman Mill County Park. Via the grant process, funding for these acquisitions was obtained: 50% from the LAWCON program, various wildlife programs with local matching funding from the County Board.

The park is open, developed and maintained for the public via operational funding by Rock County.

This contract is our next 10-year partnership agreement with FBM, Inc. In 1991, the first agreement was entered into between Rock County and FBM. The second 10-year partnership agreement provides for a continued partnership for the next 10 years. FBM will continue to operate and maintain the historic Beckman Mill, dam and fish passage on the west fork of Raccoon Creek and the creamery/visitor center, and blacksmith shop (except for the public toilets maintained by Rock County).

At the present time, the current lease is due for renewal. This lease updates the exhibits and modifies some of the agreement elements to reflect actual operations.

This resolution is to provide a long-term agreement with the Friends of Beckman Mill, Incorporated (FBM), to fund, operate, maintain and program the Beckman Mill Museum Complex on approximately two acres of park land.

The agreement has also received approval from the DNR.

FBM is incorporated in the State of Wisconsin and has federal 501(3)(c) tax exempt status.

## Rock County Department of Public Works Division of Parks – Issue Paper

**ISSUE:** Discussion and Possible Action on Rental Rates for Turtle Creek Parkway Facility

**<u>DISCUSSION:</u>** The Turtle Creek Parkway Building improvements are nearing completion. In anticipation of the upcoming rental season, rental rates for the facility need to be established. With the established park shelter rental and other permit processes the thought is that the general department permit form can be used for the rental of the Turtle Creek Parkway Building. The process would parallel the shelter rental process. It is recommended that as with Shelter Rentals we only have one renter per day. Recommended hours of rental would be 8 am – 9pm. with Director approval and permit for rental hours beyond the established hour. Specific building policies and brochures are being finalized.

125.00 for Resident Rentals and 150.00 for Non-Resident Rentals - Weekday 8am - 5pm for Resident Rental and 300.00 Non-Resident Rental for Weekend Rentals 8am - 9pm.
