7. <u>Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements</u>. No citizens wished to address the board.

Supervisor Sweeney announced that each supervisor should have the 2009 copy of *Rock County – Wisconsin's Front Porch*. The publication is free to the public and is a compilation of events, parks, accommodations and other information about the county. Each year the Board of Supervisors contributes financially to make this publication possible. Supervisor Sweeney also announced that there is a draft for the February 4, 2009 Workshop to Protect Working Lands at the Pontiac Convention Center from 9:30am – 3:00pm. Guest speaker Bob Wagner from the American Farmland Trust will focus on Agriculture-related industries for Rock County's future economic development. Please plan on attending.

Supervisor Joiner shared a Report to the Rock County Board of Health on the 2008 Pharmaceutical Collection Events as presented by Tim Banwell. 972 pounds of unwanted pharmaceuticals were collected in 2008, compared to only 430 pounds in 2007. DATCP has suspended the 2009 Grant awards while state budget priorities are established, meaning that the RX Roundup Planning Committee will be exploring alternative options to keep this program alive.

Supervisor Fizzell appealed to the board on behalf of the Merrill CommUnity Center, Inc. in Beloit. Throughout the year, hundreds of children and families are served by providing resources that empower them to be productive citizens. A wish list and donation envelope was distributed to each supervisor.

Supervisors Grahn and Fizzell introduced a resolution to support "Vision 2020", a cooperative effort to end childhood poverty in Rock County and seek to ensure that every child has the opportunity to grow and develop into a healthy, productive citizen. In December of 2008, the Rock County Economic Support Division reported that 14,071 children in this county received economic support or assistance. 35.6% of households with children in Rock County live at or below poverty level. We must coordinate with area agencies involved with "Vision 2020" and act now to improve these conditions. Supervisor Grahn explained that in conjunction with this resolution, they are providing a video presentation under reports to create awareness in our community.

Supervisor Fizzell and Supervisor Grahn shared a presentation, which is one of five presentations dealing with issues relating to poverty. This video is a PBS presentation and will be available for viewing from Karen Cain of the Rock County Health Department. The video lasted approximately fifteen minutes.
