## JUSTICE & MENTAL HEALTH GRANT PROGRAM AD HOC COMMITTEE (CJCC) April 1, 2011

<u>Call to Order</u>. Chair Deupree called the meeting to order at 1:01 P.M. in conference room N-1 on the fifth floor of the Rock County Courthouse-East.

Approval of Agenda. Mr. Olsen moved approval of the agenda as presented, second by Mr. Luster. ADOPTED.

<u>Approval of Minutes of March 11, 2011</u>. Ms. Kulinski moved approval of the minutes of, seconded by Ms. Flanagan. APPROVED

<u>Discussion of Agenda and timeline for visiting consultants</u>. The consultant asked about AODA treatment organizations represented on the visiting team interviews. Several providers of these services were suggested to be invited for interviews. Neil will check to make sure they were included in Elizabeth's email. [Most were. Associates in Psychotherapy & Family Services will be notified & invited.]

There was also discussion of who might be chauffeurs. Mr. Deupree was confident that between Elizabeth, Neil & Kay, we should be able to get the team to the sites on time.

At the welcome and wrap-up sessions, there will be the opportunity to ask questions of the consultants and for them to ask more of the community. Kate will have coffee prepared for the Monday morning meeting and Linda will get donuts. We anticipate that between 25 and 40 people might attend the opening and closing sessions.

Linda was asked about "Defense Attorneys". She indicated that Kelly Mattingly and Jack Hoag would represent that group.

Monday evening, the meeting at the Hedberg is open to the public and will be conducted as a forum.

Mr. Deupree was reminded to have a map of the county showing locations of the various law enforcement offices and of the various treatment facilities. [Map has been obtained from Planning Dept]

The four scenarios for the "table top" review were read and discussed. It was felt that these do represent important examples of situations with which we deal. The situations will bring attention to some of the known gaps in our services. We need to be open and honest about such problems. The scenarios will be given to the consultants in advance.
