Approval of Minutes – March 12, 2009.

Supervisors Fizzell and Johnson moved the approval of the minutes of March 12, 2009, as presented. ADOPTED as presented by acclamation.

7. Citizen Participation, Communications and Announcements.

Edie Baran of Hanover, WI addressed the board about an upcoming production of Working, Celebrate the American Worker, a musical based on the book Working, by Studs Terkel. The musical will be performed at Janesville Performing Arts Center April 20-26, 2009. Ms. Baran appealed to the board of Supervisors to participate in the Working. Celebrate the American Worker project by hosting an exhibit during the week at JPAC that celebrates the Rock County Worker.

Ronnie E. Thomas of Janesville, WI addressed the board to encourage them to vote to make the Coroner position an elected post. Mr. Thomas has been a resident here for more than fifty years and hasn't missed an opportunity to vote. This position has been elected since Wisconsin became a state, and by changing this position by using a loophole in the statutes, it seems as though his rights are being railroaded out the door.

Jason Dowd of Janesville, WI addressed the board to encourage them to vote to make the Coroner position an elected post. Mr. Dowd was a candidate in the 1998 and 2000 election for Rock County Coroner and believes strongly in the ability of the Rock County Voter to elect this person at large. It would not be right in his opinion to appoint this position to a medical examiner based on one person's actions, especially since the position of medical examiner is reserved for counties over 500,000; we're only at 160,000.

Supervisor Thomas invited people to a discussion being held on Thursday, April 2, 2009 at Blackhawk Technical College, Room 1400B from 3:00-5:30 p.m. This discussion is being hosted by the Rock County Transportation Coordination Committee and topics include more flexible transportation options for elderly, disabled and low-income residents; expanding transportation for late evening and early morning shift employees; and increased funding to expand evening & weekend transportation and more.

Supervisor Ott shared information about the "Walk Across Rock County" program hosted by the Ice Age Park and Trail Foundation. This program encourages folks to challenge themselves to walk Rock County's 20.9 miles of connecting routes. Call (608) 312-0755 with questions or for more information.

Administrator Knutson referred the board to two memos at their desk. First is the memo from Scott Heinig, Director, Planning & Development Agency discussing a resolution coming forward to the full board on April 23rd. The resolution supports adoption of the Rock County Southern Regional Airport Land Use Plan and the Airport Overlay Zoning District Ordinance. Secondly, the Organizational Meeting of the County Board will be held as part of the regular County Board meeting on April 23rd. If Supervisors have proposed rule changes, they need to be submitted to Mr. Jeff Kuglitsch for drafting no later than Tuesday, April 7th.

Jenifer Keach of Janesville, addressed the Board as the current Coroner, appointed in 2005 and elected in 2006 by 51,870 voters. Ms. Keach asked the Board to make the decision that they feel is right and reminded the Board that she will serve faithfully in her position either way.

Chair Podzilni asked Supervisor Kraft and Administrator Knutson to come to the podium. Supervisor Kraft recognized Mr. Knutson for 30 years of service to Rock County on behalf of the Employee Recognition Committee.

10.A. Legislative Update.

Assistant to the Administrator Phil Boutwell presented State Budget Impacts on Counties and the Families they Serve. Mr. Boutwell explained (as well as providing a detailed handout) that the 2009-11 state biennial budget significantly cuts funding to counties for safety net services. In these times of fiscal crisis, more hard working Rock County families are turning to the County for assistance. If the budget as submitted by the Governor is adopted, counties will not be able to provide safety net services in a timely manner, placing children and families at risk.

Mr. Boutwell explained that the current biennial budget as presented shifts \$2,638,113 of costs to the county for services in the following programs: Children & Families (Basic County Allocations) \$838,881; Youth Aids \$460,454; Juvenile Correctional Rate Increase \$88,462; Income Maintenance \$294,716; Mental Health Placements to State Facilities \$579,600; IV-E Children and Family Funds (due to the deficit reduction act) \$366,000.

Total Human Services cuts are actually greater than the amounts listed above. Many of the 1% "across the board" cuts have not been accounted for, as well as the \$15 million taken from county nursing homes under the CPE program, which affects Rock Haven. Mr. Boutwell detailed three pages of specific programs with 2010 impacts and shows a Net Impact of Governor's Budget on Rock County's 2010 Budget to be \$1,538,661 of reduced state aid and increased costs. This is not an all-inclusive figure.

The difficult task ahead is to get in and appeal to restore funding through Legislative lobbying.

Administrator Knutson added that the annual budget is \$170 million of which \$55 million is through property tax levy. A 3% increase in the levy is about \$1.6 million and that won't cover

the impact of the Governor's budget proposal. Rock County lost more than 6,000 jobs and the demand for services, such as income maintenance, is at its highest. To further complicate things, many state funds have been frozen since the mid 1990's and we've seen zero increase. Add to that the fact that in the mid 90's the caseload was about 5,000 and today is about 15,000 and we've had no increase in funding in Economic Support.

Supervisors asked what they can do to support appropriately funding County mandated services. Supervisor Grahn and Kuznacic reminded of a listening session on April 2 from 5-7p.m. at Blackhawk Technical College.

Mr. Boutwell summarized these cuts as a budget crisis and asked the Board to help in lobbying Speaker Sheridan, Senator Robson, Representatives Hixson and Benedict to place a high priority of these items because the impact to citizens means longer wait times for services and/or cuts to services.
