ROCK COUNTY LAND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE TUESDAY MARCH 3, 2020, 7:00 P.M. LAND CONSERVATION DEPARTMENT CONFERENCE ROOM 440 N US HWY 14 JANESVILLE WI

Call to Order: Chair Bostwick called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm.

Committee Members Present: Stephanie Aegerter, Rich Bostwick, Wes Davis, James Quade, Alan Sweeney and Jeremy Zajac.

Committee Members Excused: Robert Potter, Kaelyb Lokrantz

Others Present: Josh Smith, County Administrator, Tom Sweeney, LCD; Chris Murphy, LCD; Tom Brien, County Board Member and Marilla Smith, Citizen.

- 2. **Approval of Agenda:** Supervisor Sweeney moved to approve the agenda as presented, seconded by Supervisor Davis. **Motion Carried.**
- 3. **Approval of Minutes February 5, 2020 LCC meeting:** Supervisor Davis moved the minutes from the February 5, 2020 LCC meeting, seconded by Supervisor Quade **Motion Carried.**
- 4. **Citizen Participation, Communications, and Announcements:** Chair Bostwick asked if the Spring Land Conservation Practice tour could be scheduled for June 4, 2020, tour date was set. Supervisor Aegerter noted the Janesville Farmers market is set for this Saturday at St. Johns Church from 9-1pm.
- 5. **Review Bills Paid:** The committee reviewed the bills paid. No questions were asked.
- 6. **Succession Plan/Future Staff Considerations: Josh Smith,** County Administrator started the conversation stating that Thomas Sweeney will be retiring this spring. Mr. Smith noted there are many steps to replace a Department Head which include two interviews. The first interview session will be conducted by Administration, HR Director, and an outside third party. The second interviews will include the committee and administration. So the process could take two plus months. Supervisor Sweeney noted that the Land Conservation Department is currently involved in numerous projects that will take a thorough understanding of each. Chair Bostwick noted that the PACE program and the Groundwater Nitrate program are the two most critical programs since they are not replicated in the state. Supervisor Sweeney asked if the interviews would be held at the end of April. Mr. Smith stated that would be his goal. All questions regarding the fill of the County Conservationist position should be sent to Mr. Smith and CC all LCC members. Mr. Smith stated he will have a resolution for the next LCC meeting authorizing to double fill the position.
- 7. Construction Site Erosion Control/Storm Water Management Approval of 6 Month Extension for Permit EC-2018-11 Zach Knutson: Chris Murphy noted this permit will expired on March 1, 2020. The remaining activity that must be completed to meet the permit conditions is leveling of a soil stock pile seeding and mulching. Chris Murphy is requesting a 6 month extension or until September 1, 2020. Supervisor Zajac moved the request to extend the permit as presented, seconded by Supervisor Sweeney. Motion Carried.

- 8. **Update Groundwater Workgroup Activities.** Tom Sweeney noted that the next Producer led watershed development meeting will be held at the Craig Center, Rock County Fair Grounds on March 9, 2020 at 7:00 pm. Tom Sweeney asked if Committee members were interested in attending. The response will require an officially notified meeting. Tom Sweeney will develop an agenda for this meeting. Also the next Groundwater Nitrate Meeting will be held on March 16, 2020 in the Harmony Town Hall.
- 9. **Purchase of Agricultural Conservation Easements Update**. Tom Sweeney provided an update which included finalizing the 2020 applications to be submitted to USDA-NRCS as soon as the ranking worksheets have been released.
- 10. **Resolution:** <u>Amending the 2020 Land Conservation Department Budget Purchase a GPS</u> <u>Survey Grade Instrument Package</u>. Chair Bostwick introduced the resolution. Tom Sweeney explained the need to update the current equipment. Supervisor Aegerter moved to approve the resolution as presented, seconded by Supervisor Zajac. **Motion Carried**.
- 11. **Resolution:** Extending the Deadline for the Workgroup to Study the High Nitrates in Rock <u>County's Groundwater</u>. Chair Bostwick introduced the resolution. Tom Sweeney explained the need to extend the workgroups mission until December 31, 2025. Supervisor Quade moved the resolution as presented, seconded by Supervisor Aegerter. Motion Carried.
- 12. **Adjourn:** Supervisor Sweeney moved to adjourn the March 3, 2020 Land Conservation Committee meeting at 7:56 pm, seconded by Supervisor Quade. **Motion Carried.**

RE: Erosion Control & Storm Water Management Permit Application Fee

To the Rock County Land Conservation Committee,

MS Properties of Rock County is the owner of the property at 5705 N Milton-Shopiere Rd, Milton WI as of October 4, 2019. In the months following the purchase of this property some work was done on the property to prepare the site for the addition of a new shop building to the property. When the excavation work was done by Frank Silha & Sons Excavating, I was unaware that some of the area we were working in was part of the storm water area and thus I would need an Erosion Control & Storm Water Management Permit to complete the work. This property is a gravel pit and the entire property is zoned as such. The mining area is only approximately 500 feet away from the area disturbed and of course has no storm water management rules to follow. Given these facts, I thought the area disturbed would be exempt from the need for a permit as well.

It was brought to our attention when a Land Conservation employee visited the property that this particular area of the property was considered part of the storm water area. Since then we have worked with Combs & Associates to revise the plans for the area to meet the Land Conservation specifications. The new plan, with the exception of 800 SF more Bio Basin Area, is no different than the previous plan. I have also paid \$1,535 in fines for the work that was previously performed. When the application for the permit was submitted the Land Conservation staff had charged the double permit fee according to sections 4.809 and 4.1109 of the County Ordinance, before they would process the application. In an effort to keep the construction project moving forward, I have paid the double fee. I am requesting that the Rock County Land Conservation Committee consider refunding the double fee due to the situation and that I acted in good faith and did not intentionally violate any Ordinances. The work that was performed did not cause any erosion/silt to leave the site. I have complied with all requests and paid all fines since it was brought to my attention that a permit was required. The amount of the request is \$1,601.50.
