AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF MOTOR POOL VEHICLES FOR THE ROCK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

The purpose of this resolution is to authorize the purchase of three (3) 2020 Dodge Grand Caravans to be utilized by the Rock County Human Services Department, Rock County ARDC and Rock County AODA/Treatment Court. The vehicle to be utilized by the Rock County Human Services Department will be a replacement for MP 4, a 2012 Chevrolet Impala with 89,492 miles, this Impala may be reintroduced into the fleet as a loaner vehicle. The vehicles for the Rock County ARDC and Rock County AODA will be new additions to the motor pool.

Therefore, it is recommended that three (3) 2019 Dodge Grand Caravans be acquired from the current best bid on the State Vehicle bid program, through Ewald Automotive Group of Oconomowoc, Wisconsin.
