Executive Summary

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 increased the national bond cap for Qualified Energy Conservation Bonds (QECB) to \$3.2 billion. These bonds may be issued by state and local governments to finance qualified energy conservation projects. The County's portion of the QECB allocation is \$1,663,782.

The School District of Beloit has requested the County reallocate its QECB allocation to the School District. The County does not have a project in the foreseeable future that would qualify for QECB financing and no other eligible Rock County municipality has requested a reallocation of the County's bonding authority. This resolution reallocates Rock County's allocation of \$1,663,782 in QECB bonding authority to the School District of Beloit.
