Supervisor Brill said at the last meeting he had asked about the County paying to have fathers' names put on birth certificates. He received a call from Ms. Baker Ellis explaining that this is court ordered. She added they receive 66% federal funding to cover this cost, which they pay back after the mother or father pays them.

## Purchase of Electrical Surge Protection Equipment for the 911 Communications Center.

### Awarding Contract for Construction of Sheriff's Office Vehicle Storage Building.

hereby award a contract for construction of the Sheriff's Office vehicle storage building to the lowest qualified bidder, Corporate Contractors, Inc., of Beloit, Wisconsin, in the amount of \$230,755."

Supervisor Brill moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Knudson. ADOPTED.

### <u>Approval of Additional Data Connections at the Communications Center Back-Up</u> <u>Site.</u>

Supervisor Wiedenfeld moved approval of the above request, second by Supervisor Brill.

Mr. Sleeter said there was a misunderstanding in the number of data connections needed at the Town of Beloit Communications Center Back-up Site. We are approximately \$11,600 under budget for this project at this time and we need \$2,921.40 for the additional needed data connections. ADOPTED.

**Semi-Annual Report.** The Committee accepted reports from the 911 Communications Center, Clerk of Courts, Mediation and Family Court Services and the Sheriff's Office and directed they be placed on file.

<u>2009 Activity Report – Mediation and Family Court.</u> Ms. Costrini-Norgal went over the report and answered questions.

<u>Countywide Communications Upgrade.</u> Mr. Boutwell informed the Committee he and Mr. Sleeter are continuing to meet with different groups. They also met with Sheriff Spoden for about an hour before he left for Washington D.C., where he will be meeting on this issue with staff at the White House.

Mr. Sleeter said he feels it is important to move quickly to get a grant writer. The Cities of Janesville and Beloit are on board with this and they need to form a consensus of all the other entities. Mr. Boutwell added he does not anticipate any problems as everyone seems to understand this is something they are required to do. He added they have not heard anything negative. They have all known this is coming for the past 18 - 24 months. A letter writing campaign to our legislative delegation is the next step.

Mr. Sleeter said if the public works departments, transit systems, etc. do not want to be part of this they do not need to, but it would be in their best interest to get on board, especially if they would like to get any grant funding.

Supervisor Beaver asked what it would take to knock out this system? Mr. Sleeter replied this is a UHF/VHF system and they still have Simplex. There are also stand-by towers, and if all else fails we go to ham radios. Mr. Boutwell said he has confidence in what we have.

Ms. Keach asked if someone opted out at this time, would they be able to come in later? Mr. Sleeter replied they would be able to, however, they would do it on their own and most likely not receive any grant funding. <u>Committee Requests and Motions.</u> Supervisor Wiedenfeld asked when the back-up site in the Town of Beloit would be open and ready to hold a meeting there? Mr. Sleeter said it would be after March before it would be ready.

Chair Collins asked Ms. Keach to get in touch with Ms. Bondehagen to see when it would be a good time to meet at the Coroner's office.

<u>Adjournment</u>. Supervisor Brill moved adjournment at 4:50 P.M., second by Supervisor Beaver. ADOPTED.
