Awarding Contract for Construction of Sheriff's Office Vehicle Storage Building

"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled this _____ day of _____, 2010 does hereby award a contract for construction of the Sheriff's Office vehicle storage building to the lowest qualified bidder, Corporate Contractors, Inc., of Beloit, Wisconsin, in the amount of \$230,755."

Discussion on the \$10,000 budgeted for the removal of the building, to use these funds to move the building to the site for the gardens, to hold off on pouring concrete and installing electrical and water. Chair Owens requested Mr. Dransfield check into the costs of moving the building to the site and letting it sit there. Mr. Dransfield said he will pull these costs together. ADOPTED on the following vote: 4-0-1 with Supervisor Combs abstaining.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Clerk is authorized to send copies of this resolution to the Rock County Legislative Delegation, the Wisconsin Counties Association and all other County Clerks in the State to elicit support for this requested change in State law."

Supervisor Brill moved approval for the above resolution with a change to line 16, to change the word "process" to "option", second by Supervisor Mawhinney. ADOPTED.
