WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act or the CARES Act of 2020, the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Infectious Diseases (ELC) program has awarded additional funds to Wisconsin for COVID-19 response activities; and,

WHEREAS, the intention of this additional funding is to rapidly establish and monitor key activities related to COVID-19 in the areas of epidemiology, laboratory, and informatics; and,

WHEREAS, monitoring the indicators associated with these activities are intended to assist State, local, and territorial governments in making data-driven policy decisions regarding testing, mitigation, and prevention efforts; and,

WHEREAS, the Rock County Public Health Department will utilize the additional funding to enhance ability to identify cases, conduct contact tracing and follow up and implement recommended containment measures. Along with improving morbidity and mortality surveillance, enhance reporting capacity, work with healthcare systems to manage and monitor system capacity and work to improve understanding of jurisdictional communities with respect to COVID-19 risk.
