Supervisor Combs moved the Purchasing Procedural Endorsement and Contract Award for Exterior Metal Wall Panels for the Health Department to Metal Design Corporation, Madison, WI, in the amount of \$3,866.00, second by Supervisor Collins. ADOPTED.

UW-Rock County Project.

<u>Update Report</u>. Mr. Leu said he had a meeting last week with Paul Ament, Jim Martin and Dave Beck-Engel and they went through the list item by item. The largest issues, sewer and landscaping, still remain. He distributed a memo on the sewer and went through it with the Committee. He explained correcting the sewer pitch will require tearing up the landscaping and the lighting because they will have to dig down 18 feet. Mr. Leu said nothing has been decided at this time on the landscaping.

Mr. Leu said he sent a letter to Dean Pillard and Mr. Pierick on the parking design for the tennis court area. He anticipates having this ready to bid in the spring.

Mr. Leu distributed the results of his negotiations on the UW-Rock County Project. There were 206 proposal requests/change orders. The cost of the ones that were voided because the work was originally on the plans, plus the ones where the cost was challenged, went from \$370,650 to \$131,015, for a savings of \$239,015.

Supervisor Collins asked the status of the punch list, with Mr. Leu advising it is 95% completed. Supervisor Mawhinney suggested a letter be forwarded to the County Board on the status of the UW-Rock County landscaping.
