The Rock River Trail Initiative (RRTI) was founded in 2010 with the emphasis of creating a National Water Trail through National Park Service endorsement and accreditation which was established in 2012. Since then the RRTI's focus has expanded into developing driving, biking, and hiking routes to promote recreational opportunities, ecotourism, and awareness along the Rock River corridor from its headwaters in Horicon, WI to its confluence with the Mississippi River in Rock Island, IL.

On July 5, 2013 Senate Bill 41 was enacted to create 84.10225 of WI statutes; relating to: designating and marking a specified highway route in the counties of Rock, Dane, Jefferson, Dodge and Fond du Lac as the Rock River Trail Scenic and Historic Route (SHR).

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets forth the terms and understanding between the County of Rock and the Rock River Trail Initiative to set the terms and conditions of the signing, installation, and maintenance of the Rock River Trail Scenic and Historic Route.
