Small Business and Farm Chemical Disposal

Does your small business or farm have unwanted chemicals for disposal?



Rock County is hosting a Clean Sweep Chemical Collection Program to assist eligible local small businesses and farms in proper disposal of their unwanted hazardous chemicals. Clean Sweep offers a convenient, safe, and low cost way to dispose of your unwanted hazardous chemicals. Rock County is partnering with Veolia North America to provide collection and disposal services. Please help us protect your Rock County environment through participation in this chemical collection program.

Small Business Participation and Fees:

Generally most small businesses will be eligible to participate, if they are classified as Very Small Quantity Generators of hazardous waste by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. A Small Business that generates under 220 pounds of hazardous waste in a month and stores less than 2,205 pounds of hazardous waste in a year may qualify for Very Small Quantity Generator (VSQG) status. Veolia North America offers free guidance to interested small businesses to help determine your eligibility to participate.

Disposal fees depend on the amount and type of hazardous chemicals that you bring to the program. Agricultural related businesses that offer chemicals like pesticides or herbicides, may qualify for funding assistance from the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection.

Veolia North America provides free, no-obligation estimates of your disposal fees - simply complete and return the pre-registration and inventory form. Veolia will help determine your eligibility and will guide your participation in the program, from registration through delivery of your materials.

Farm and Agricultural Participation:

Eligible Farms and Agricultural Producers are defined as anyone who produces an agricultural commodity on land that the person owns or controls. The Clean Sweep program, to collect unwanted hazardous chemicals from Farms and Agricultural Producers, does require pre-registration. All Farms and Agricultural Producers must contact Rock County (608-754-6617 ext. 4758) to pre-register and confirm their participation drop-off time. Farms and Agricultural Producers have no disposal fees for the first 200 lbs of ag chemicals.

Pre-Registration is Required:

Small businesses, Farms and Agricultural Producers who want to participate in the Clean Sweep Chemical Collection Program must pre-register, as outlined below.

Pre-Register by June 19th for June collection and by August 14th for August collection.
