Gulf War Illness Presumptive Eligibility

A veteran must have a current diagnosis of one of the GWI conditions along with the following:

 Served in the Southwest Asia theater of military operations during the Gulf War period and you didn't receive a dishonorable discharge

Both of these must be true. Your illness or condition:

- Caused you to be ill for at least 6 months, and
- Resulted in a disability rating of 10% or more

Gulf War Illness Presumptives

- Functional gastrointestinal disorders
- Chronic fatigue syndrome
- Fibromyalgia
- Other undiagnosed illnesses, including but not limited to cardiovascular disease, muscle and joint pain, and headaches
